Best Bar None started in Edmonton in 2010. The program aims to reduce alcohol-related harms by raising the operating standards of licensed premises as well as building positive relationships among the licensees, law enforcement, industry partners and community groups. The program uses a system of assessment, accreditation and awards to engage nightspots in responsible management and safe operations.

Best Bar None partners include the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission, the City of Edmonton and the Edmonton Police Service. The program is also supported by community agencies such as the Public Safety Compliance Team, the Alberta Safer Bars Council and Responsible Hospitality Edmonton.
